

Funding for Education in the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA), Enacted February 17, 2009

ARRA: Division A, Title XIV – State Fiscal Stabilization Fund	Subtotals	Est. Texas Allocations
Entire amount of State Fiscal Stabilization Fund is available upon enactment of the bill.		
After US Department of Education (USDE) administrative set-asides, the State allocation is based 61% on relative population of individuals ages 5-24 and 39% on the basis of their relative total population.		
State Grants - State Uses of Funds:		
1. For each fiscal year, the Governor shall use 81.8% for the support of elementary, secondary, and post-secondary education and, as applicable, early childhood education programs and services.	\$3,250,272,133	
2. The Governor shall use 18.2% for public safety and other government services, which may include assistance for elementary and secondary schools and public IHEs and for modernization, renovation, or repairs of public school and IHE facilities, consistent with recognized green building rating system.	\$723,165,683
