

SRF email blasts/notifications

1. 10/2008 - CW/DWSRF FY 2010 IUP Solicitation Packets was mailed to 3,700 potential applicants
2. 10/2008 - approximately 500 invitation letters were sent to potential applicants (public and private water systems, and city and county officials) inviting them to attend the Board's scheduled SRF Workshops held in various parts of the state.
3. 10/19/08 - We informed potential applicants that the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) would be conducting SRF workshops around the state to share information on the low-cost financial for water and wastewater construction projects. The focus of these workshops was on the Drinking Water and Clean Water Revolving Fund programs, including how to fill out required worksheets and forms to be included in the next funding cycle.
4. 12/5/08 - Incorporated CW and DW SRF deadlines into the State Participation letter sent to potential applicants informing them about the availability of funding and the application deadline (January 2, 2009) for both State Participation Assistance and Water Infrastructure Assistance.
5. 12/2008 - Incorporated CW and DW SRF deadlines into the State Participation proposed rule amendments.
6. 3,700 economic stimulus letters were mailed on 12/29/08 to potential applicants (public water system officials, financial advisors, bond council, and engineers). This is the letter that KW signed and was posted on our website back in December.
7. 01/10/09 - Economic Recovery Funds contact list was developed based on the applications received from potential applicants. During the months of December 2008 through January 2009, we received approximately 678 submittals (applications) for DWSRF IUPs; and logged in approximately 584 telephone calls into our database.
8. 01/22/09 - State Revolving Funds and Federal Economic Recovery Funds reminder notification was sent to potential water and wastewater project consultants reminding them about the deadline for submitting applications for both DW and CWSRF forms (January 23, 2009 and January 30, 2009 respectively). This notification was also sent to consulting engineers.
